Local rules apply and will be posted at the show.

- 1) Open to all breeds, any type.
- 2) Open to all vehicles: pneumatic, wooden and steel wheeled vehicles allowed in all classes.
- 3) Hats, gloves, apron and whip in hand mandatory in all classes, including obstacles.
- 4) Helmet required for all youth exhibitors. Youth exhibitors may have an adult passenger.
- 5) The judge may require three trots (slow trot, working trot, strong trot), walk and rein back.
- 6) Under no condition shall a bridle be removed from a horse while it is still put to a vehicle. Lines must be IN THE HANDS of the driver or assistant driver at all times.
- 7) Horse(s) hitched to a vehicle shall NOT be tied, or left unattended.
- 8) Exhibitor number to be clearly visible.
- 9) Equine leg protection permissible in Obstacle (timed) classes.
- 10) Exhibitor may show more than one entry in the same Obstacle (timed) class.
- 11) Multiples are required to have a passenger or groom.
- 12) Definitions:

Youth Driver:

18 years old and under.

Multiples:

More than one equine hitched and driven to a wheeled vehicle.

Singles:

One equine hitched and driven to a wheeled vehicle.

Open: Singles and multiple equines hitched and driven to a wheeled vehicle.

VSE (Very Small Equine:) Equines measuring less than 39" at the withers.

- 13) All Open classes are open to singles and multiples.
- 14) Youth classes are open to all sizes of equines.
- 15) There will be no combining of classes divided by horse height without the agreement of the exhibitors.
- 16) If any questions arise, the current American Driving Society rules will be consulted and used as the deciding factor.

- 17) Entries are subject to measurement at management's discretion in classes divided by height.
