## Rules

- 1) The contest is open to any team of horses weighing in excess of 2500 lbs. per team without harness. The weight classes will be Light Weight 2500 lbs. to 3500 lbs. and Heavy Weight 3501 and over.
- 2) All teams entering this contest will be weighed singly, without harness, on a certified scale on the fairgrounds. Officials will weigh horses only once and the combined weight of the team will be the official weight. Weights will break on the nearest 50 lbs.
- 3) All horses entered for competition in the draft team pulling are subject to testing for use of stimulants and/or drugs during and after the contest by a Veterinarian. Any horse or team showing evidence of drugging will be disqualified and all premiums and fees forfeited.
- 4) Drivers that cannot control their teams from endangering the safety of the other participants will be disqualified by the judge.
- 5) The driver of each team is entitled to have no more than 2 helpers in handling the team. The helpers must not try in any way to assist the driver while the team is in the act of pulling. Driver and helpers must be in back or even with the double-trees at all times. No heading will be allowed.
- 6) No driver or helper will be allowed to use profane language. There shall be no whipping of the team with the lines or whip, no hot shot or any other abuse of the team while in the act of pulling or while on the grounds.

- 7) Each driver will be allowed three pulls to pull the entire measured distance. The measured distance shall be 20 feet.
- 8) The team will pull a weight based on class weight of team.
- 9) If a team does not successfully complete the 20 feet distance in 3 pulls, the team is eliminated from further participation in the contest. The weight and distance pulled, feet and inches, will remain on the official record for this team.
- 10) There will be no tie. There will be a pull off between teams for 1st. place. Only one try allowed for the pull at this time.
- 11) To qualify, each team will be required to pull 100% of its weight. A rope-marked pulling alley, with borders 15 feet wide will be used to help align teams. The judge will whistle if a horse steps on or crosses the barrier and all distance accumulated will be disqualified. The puller will have remaining pulls to accumulate distance.
- 12) The double-tree bolt may be set off-center.
- 13) If at any time during the contest there is any breakage of any of the equipment, reasonable time will be given for repairs. If a tug comes loose or equipment failure, the option of keeping the distance or a repull will be allowed.
- 14) All spectators who are not connected with the contest will be prohibited from entering the ring.
- 15) All rules are subject to modification by draft pull coordinator to make a better class for the good of the pull.
- 16) The judge may determine the direction of each pull. If only two teams are left at the beginning of the last pull, the drivers may choose their direction.
- 17) The judge will allow 2 minutes for each team to get hooked up.
- 18) There will be no switching or splitting of teams during the pull.
- 19) No change of bridles during the pull (if horses enter the pulling ring with open bridles, they may pull with open bridles).
- 20) Excessive bumps will not be allowed or teams will be disqualified.
- 21) To start the pull the double-trees must be on the ground. and when the double-trees hit the ground that is the end of that pull.
- 22) The pull begins when the driver calls for his horses.
- 23) The New Mexico State Fair and the State of New Mexico will not be responsible for any loss from fire, theft or accident. They will assume no liability for any accident that may arise affecting driver or team adversely or otherwise and is hereby held harmless and blameless for any such accident.
