# Creative Arts

## General Rules

1. Entries in this department are limited to residents of New Mexico.
2. Only amateurs who make or craft as a hobby are eligible to compete for prizes.
3. Commercial or professional parties may exhibit for display only if space permits and shall not be judged.
4. No person shall make multiple entries under one class number. Exhibits and parts shall be entered in only one group or section each.
5. Exhibits wrongly classified shall be placed in the proper class.
6. All entries shall comply with the requirements as set forth in the New Mexico State Fair Premium book.
7. The decision of the judges will be final.
8. Please address entries being delivered by UPS, FED EX., etc. in care of New Mexico State Fair, Superintendent, Creative Arts Center, 300 San Pedro NE, Gate 4, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87108. If you mail entries through the United States Post Office, they must be addressed in care of the New Mexico State Fair, Superintendent, Creative Arts Center, P.O. Box 8546, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87198. **MAILED ENTRIES MUST ARRIVE BY AUGUST 31, 2011.**
9. Exhibitors are responsible for picking up their own exhibits or providing written authorization for pick-up by another individual.
10. Upon presentation of claim checks, all exhibits will be released only on **Monday, September 26th, 9:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.** Any exhibits remaining on the Fairgrounds after the designated pick up date of September 26, 2011 will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the New Mexico State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion.
11. Exhibitor recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Exhibitor hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish exhibitor images and property without the need for any other approval. Exhibitor also releases the Fair, its agents or assigns, from all claims related to the licenses that have been granted in this release.

## Special Rules

1. The exhibitor must construct all models.
2. Entries must never have been entered in a previous New Mexico State Fair.
3. Due to space limitations, No exhibits will be accepted for display only.
4. Entries will be entered in specific class; otherwise model will be entered in the miscellaneous class.
5. One entry per exhibitor per class.
6. Classification and acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of officials.
7. The judges will determine qualification or disqualification of any entry in question.
8. Judges may reclassify entries if needed.
9. Entry tags will not be tied to item.
10. Models and diorama bases shall not exceed 15"x20" or 300 sq. inches.
11. Space for large models is very limited. Display of large models will be at the discretion of officials.
12. All ribbon winners will be displayed.
13. Non-ribbon exhibits will be displayed only if space permits.
14. Quality is emphasized and entries are judged by means, which recognize workmanship, scale authenticity, finish and presentation.

# Section 454 - Adult

## Classes 1-27

1. Box Stock – Model built straight from the box. No additional detail except for paint and foil. Use of putty to fill in manufacturing flaws such as seams and sink marks permitted. Instructions for model preferred.
2. Factory Stock - Car is as sold from the manufacturer, replicating showroom condition.
3. Foreign/Exotic - Car made outside the USA, or not commonly seen on the street
4. Muscle Car - Recognized super car, must be built factory or showroom stock. No Modifications.
5. Street Machine - Post '49 Body style. Any engine, treaded tires, & exhaust system with mufflers. Built for performance.
6. Street Rod - Pre '48 Body style. Any engine, treaded tires, and exhaust system with mufflers. Built for performance.
7. Pro-Street - Wheel tubs, treaded tires or slicks, any engine, roll bar or cage, seat belts or harness, fire extinguisher, exhaust system with mufflers. Floor pan must fit out to the inner portions of the body panels. Any body style.
8. Pickups/Vans - Pickups with some sort of bed (includes stake bed). Vans are post '61 body style, stock or custom.
9. 4 X 4 - Front or rear axle drive vehicles (includes Monster trucks)
10. Custom - Any body style, any major body modifications, treaded tires, exhaust system with mufflers, any engine.
11. Lowrider Car - Custom style car utilizing low profile treaded tires.
12. Lowrider Truck - Custom style truck utilizing low profile treaded tires.
13. Big Scale - Any car or truck larger than 1/20 scale.
14. Light commercial – Delivery, pickups, etc. Used for business (business name must be on vehicle.) Includes light emergency vehicles (police, ambulance, light wrecker, etc.)
15. Heavy Commercial - Factory stock or job-specific truck, van, or bus with a 10,000 lb. minimum gross vehicle weight. Intended for commercial use (i.e. 18 wheelers, tractors, fire equipment)

16. Drag - Slicks, roll bar or cage, any engine, seat belts or harness, fire extinguisher, open or closed exhaust, any body style.
17. Competition/Open Wheel - No fenders, any body style, any engine (i.e. Indy cars, Sprint)
18. Competition/Closed Wheel - Nascar, GTO, GTU, ASA, etc.
19. Slam - Vehicle built with no engine or interior. Windows blacked out.
20. Scratch Built - Major portion of the vehicle make from styrene. brass, aluminum, etc.
21. Miscellaneous - any entry not fitting any of the other classes.
22. Motorcycle - Any scale or style motorcycle is allowed. This includes Stock production, Customs, Racing, Drag, Dirt, etc. Trikes and bicycles are also allowed. No pre-builts, must be made from a kit.
23. Diorama - Must be auto/truck/motorcycle related and be built solely by the entrant. Maximum size of diorama should not exceed 15" x 20" or 300 square inches. Note: height of diorama should not exceed 12". Must be able to fit in glass display cases. Items on diorama will not be touched by judges. Entries will be judged on scale, accuracy, basic modeling skills, and uniqueness. Aftermarket components available to the public can be used. Example: photo etched parts, resin, machined parts, decals, etc.
24. Small Scale - Any vehicle that is smaller than 1/25 scale. This includes: 1/32, 1/35, 1/43, 1/48, H.O. scale, etc. No military vehicles. Any car, truck or motorcycle is allowed. No pre-builts, must be made from a kit.
25. Die-Cast (Stock) - Any type of vehicle is permitted (stock, racing, custom, truck, motorcycle). Vehicle must be built from a kit. No pre-assembled vehicles such as Danbury Mint, Franklin Mint, Ertl, etc. are allowed. Repainting, bare metal, foil and different decals are allowed. Entrants must supply the instruction sheet with their model to verify being from a kit.
26. Die-Cast (Modified) - any type of vehicle is permitted (stock, race, custom, trucks, motorcycles, etc.). All scales are accepted. Vehicles in this class must be modified from their original appearance. Engine wiring, customizing (chopping, channeling, super detailing, repainting, etc.) are encouraged in this class. Pre-built and pre-assembled vehicles are allowed in this class (Danbury Mint, Franklin Mint, Ertl, etc.). Entrants should show what vehicle looked like before modifying, (box art, advertisement, brochure, etc.) A 3 x 5 card on modifications done is encouraged.

27. Tuner/Euro—Can be cars or trucks, built for street performance. Wings, airdams, ground effects, nitrous, etc. Special paints, graphics allowed. Can be American made vehicle or foreign fitting with the “Fast & Furious” car culture.
