## Special Rules

1. Due to space limitations, no exhibits will be accepted for display only.
2. The Albuquerque Coin Club will select three judges.
3. Judges may not enter competitive exhibits.
4. Any exhibit that wins an award may not be entered into competition the following year, except if the exhibit is changed by a minimum of 25% by removing some items and adding different items.
5. Exhibit must fit cases provided by Albuquerque Coin Club (21-1/2" x 2-1/2" x 33")
6. First come-space available: 18 total cases (Limit of 3 cases per exhibitor.)
