The Next Generation of New Mexico Film Makers

New Mexico State Fair's 2nd Annual Film Invitational

The New Mexico State will be showcasing *The Next Generation of New Mexico Film Makers* every Saturday and Sunday during Fair Time from 12:00 PM - 1:30 PM and will be free of charge at the African Performing Arts Center (AAPAC). Each screening will feature an hour and a half of short films by New Mexico students ranging from middle school to university levels.

In conjunction with *The Next Generation of New Mexico Film Makers*, we will offer four educational day workshops for New Mexico youth (ages 10-16) to introduce students to the art of film and video. These workshops will be held in the AAPAC classrooms and are scheduled to begin after film screenings.

Seats are limited to fifteen (15) students per class and pre-registration at our website www.exponm.com is **required** prior to August 31, 2009. Classes are first come, first serve and are expected to fill quickly.

Video Making Workshop - Saturday and Sunday, September 13, 2009 and September 14, 2009 - AAPAC Classrooms 2:00 PM - 3:30 PM

This workshop introduces students to VJ-style "live" video mixing techniques using live feeds, pre-recorded material, and video mixing equipment. The class suggests an alternative approach to media making that exists beyond the monolithic model of Hollywood or broadcast approaches to movie making.

Film Making Workshop - Saturday and Sunday, September 19, 2009 and September 20, 2009 - AAPAC Classrooms 2:00 PM - 3:30 PM

In this workshop, students will work with pre-developed 16mm film by drawing, scratching, and coloring the film stock to create handmade film loops. At the conclusion of the day's workshop all loops will be presented in a multi-media projector "happening". The purpose of this workshop is to de-bunk the notion that film making is a multi-million dollar "Hollywood" endeavor.
