## **Special Rules - Non Professional & Youth**

1. A Non-Professional (amateur) artist is defined as one seeking public exposure for his or her work, with limited or no gallery experience, who has or would like to participate in exhibits and fairs, and who seeks to attain a level of professional proficiency.
2. An exhibitor may submit only one entry, which must have been completed after October 1, 2008. Artists may not submit an entry in Section 245 if their work has exhibited in past years in any of the professional shows (Fine Arts, Hispanic Arts or Native American Arts). Entries will be accepted only from New Mexico residents 19 years of age or older. There will be a non refundable entry fee of \$10.00 for work submitted. A check for required amount should accompany shipped entries.
3. No exhibit shall receive an award greater than its merits justify even though there is no competition.
4. Work submitted must be original, not a copy.
5. The Fair reserves the right to jury the entries and to remove any work that is proved to be a copy.

6. All entries, excluding sculptures, must be FRAMED and wired across the back for hanging, and wire must extend two inches below the top edge of the frame. Wire must not extend above the top of the frame. Hanging brackets or loops will not be accepted. Pictures are limited in size to a maximum of 38" x 48" (framed). Size limit on sculptures, 3'x3'x3'.
7. The New Mexico State Fair is "going green". We encourage all artists to visit our web site at [www.exponm.com](http://www.exponm.com) for all entry information and to pre-register your artwork. Those without computer access may visit your local library for computer use. Otherwise, please call (505) 222-9750 or (505) 222-9738 and we will mail entry information to you. Entry cards will be available after June 20, 2009. Cards must be filled out and signed by exhibitor and turned in at the time of entry. The cards, along with a check for a non-refundable entry fee (including return shipping fees), should accompany shipped entries. If work is to be for sale, the artist must indicate the purchase price on the entry cards. There will be a 25% commission for all work sold during the fair.
8. Walk In Exhibits will be received in the Creative Arts Center, Friday, August 20, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, August 21, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM and Saturday, August 22, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. **If entry was made online, this item must be delivered to the Creative Arts Center on these dates. Please bring 1 copy of the completed online entry form.** Out-of-town entries may be shipped, prepaid (to include return shipping fees) to:

- Entries must be shipped to arrive no later than August 19, 2009.
9. Unsold exhibits must be claimed upon presentation of claim checks on **Tuesday, September 29, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.** Exhibitors are responsible for picking up their own work or providing written authorization for pick-up by another individual, including those exhibits which were mailed. Mailed or shipped entries will be returned in the same manner and in the same container received, provided funds to cover the shipping costs are included with the entry. Any exhibits remaining on the Fairgrounds after the designated pick up date of September 29, 2009 will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the New Mexico State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion.
  10. Failure to comply with the above mentioned rules will result in disqualification from jury.
  11. Exhibitor recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Exhibitor hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish exhibitor images and property without the need for any other approval. Exhibitors artwork will not be used for profit.

## Moving Image Art

The New Mexico State Fair has added a class for Moving Image Art, however, due to lack of space in the galleries, all interested artists (ages 18 & up) will submit their entries to the Fine Arts Gallery on Thursday, July 30, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Friday, July 31, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM or on Saturday, August 1, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

The description is as follows:

**Moving Image Art:** All works must be submitted in a DVD format and have a time limit of no more than 20 minutes including title card and credits. Each entry needs to have your name, title, running time, date made (no restrictions this year), 50 word synopses and artist biography.

#### **Special Rules-Youth**

1. To enter the Youth Art section, an exhibitor must be 18 years of age and under, and must be a resident of New Mexico.
2. Art work must have been completed after October 1, 2008.
3. The non-refundable entry fee for work submitted is \$5.00.
4. Except for the age and entry fee, all rules for the Youth Art Exhibit are the same as those for the Non-Professional Exhibit, Section 245.
5. Special attention should be given to Rule 6, Section 245, which states, "All entries, excluding sculpture, must be framed and wired across the back for hanging and wire must not extend above the top of the frame, maximum size 38"x48" (framed) and sculptures 3'x3'x3'.
6. Hanging brackets or loops will not be accepted." The hanging devices normally found on photograph frames are not acceptable, and if photo-frames are used, they must be wired.

### **Special Rules - Non-Professional China Painting**

1. A non-professional (amateur) artist, is one seeking public exposure for his or her work with limited or no gallery experience wishing to participate in exhibits and fairs, and who seeks to attain a level of professional proficiency.
2. New Mexico residents 18 years of age and older are eligible.
3. There will be a 25% commission charged on all work sold during the fair.
4. Each artist may submit three original works of art per class and must have been completed after October 1, 2008.

5. Artist must include signature, price of artwork if it's for sale otherwise indicate, NFS. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, or TAX ID on entry card, (number is needed if you receive a cash award or if artwork sells, your check will not be delayed. The IRS regulation requires New Mexico State Fair to withhold 31% of any payments to individuals who **DO NOT** give a correct Social Security Number.
6. Submitted entries must be by the individual artists, not by dealers. The Porcelain Art Club of Albuquerque and the New Mexico State Fair or the State of New Mexico is not liable for any loss or damage to any entry while in the Fair's possession. Artists are encouraged to carry their own insurance.
7. The New Mexico State Fair is "going green". We encourage all artists to visit our website at [www.exponm.com](http://www.exponm.com) for all entry information and to pre-register your artwork. Those without computer access may visit your local library for computer use, Otherwise, please call (505) 222-9750 or (505) 222-9738 and we will mail entry information to you. Entry cards will be available after June 20, 2009.. Entry cards must be complete and signed by the exhibitor. **If entries were made online, these items must be delivered on Thursday, August 20, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, August 21, 2009 from 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM or Saturday, August 22, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Please bring 1 copy, per entry, of completed online entry form.**

Please INCLUDE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. Out of town entries may be shipped, and must arrive no later than August 19, 2009.

A check payable to the New Mexico State Fair for entry fee (including return shipping fees) must accompany all shipped entries. Out of town entries must be shipped, prepaid to:

8. This show will be juried by competent, non-competing artists, or qualified experts.
9. All entries shall consist of porcelain, on which fired, hand-painted decoration is dominant feature. Decals will not be accepted. Framed pieces will be accepted. Figurines and ceramic pieces will not be accepted.
10. Artists may not submit entries in non-professional section if work is exhibited or has exhibited in past years in any professional exhibits (Fine Arts, Hispanic Art, Native American Art, or African American Art Galleries).
11. No entry shall receive an award greater than its merits justify, nor shall awards be given where there is lack of competition in class entered.
12. All work must be completely that of the exhibitor. No decals or copies of other artists' work are permitted.

13. Artist must provide stands, easels or other items needed for display of pieces. Please LABEL THESE WITH YOUR NAME and entry NUMBER.
14. All group pieces, and pieces with the same design, shall be entered as one unit.
15. It is imperative that all exhibitors claim their art work, **Monday, September 28, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM** by presenting their claim checks. Exhibitors are responsible for picking up their own work or providing written authorization for pick-up by another individual, including those exhibits, which were mailed. Mailed or shipped entries will be returned in the same manner and in the same container received, provided funds to cover the transportation cost are included with the entry. Any exhibits remaining on the Fairgrounds after the designated pick up date of September 28, 2009 will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the New Mexico State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion.
16. Installation is left at the discretion of the NMSF Arts Committee.
17. Failure to comply with the above-mentioned rules will result in disqualification from jury.
