Rules

1) **Eligibility**

Open to horses of any breed - registered or unregistered. New Mexico State Fair rules shall apply. Youth may not show stallions.

2) **Governing Rules**

American Quarter Horse rules as modified by NMSF will govern both the Western and English classes including tack and appointment rules.

3) **Age Determination for Youth Classes**

In Youth classes, the age of the exhibitor will be his/her age as of January 1, 2010. Youth classes are for exhibitors 18 years and under; no stallions permitted.

4) **Western Attire**

In Western classes exhibitors must wear long sleeved shirt tucked into pants, belt, boots and cowboy hat. Gloves, vest, jacket, and chaps are optional.

5) **English Attire**

Helmet mandatory in English classes.

6) **Barrels & Pole Bending Attire**

In Barrels and Pole Bending, exhibitors must wear a Western hat OR helmet. A five (5) second penalty will be assessed if the hat or helmet is **not on the head** of the exhibitor during the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena.

7) **Speed Classes**

All speed classes will be run to and from a closed gate. Exhibitors who violate this rule will be disqualified.

8) **Safety**

Management reserves the right to disqualify from competition any entry that is in manager's opinion not safely under exhibitor's control. This is a condition of entry and not subject to protest.

9) **Objections**

Any objections to class placings or High Point computation must be lodged within one half hour following the completion of the class, except for timed events which must be lodged immediately so that High Point Awards may be awarded promptly after the show is over.

10) **Definitions:**

Maiden: Horse may not have won a blue ribbon at any show prior to the closing date of entries.

Novice Youth Rider 18 & Under: Rider may not have won a blue ribbon prior to the closing date of entries in any breed show or in the NMSF All-Breed show prior to the closing date of entries.
