Rules

- 1) Three Chances for Points!** The New Mexico State Fair has been approved by AQHA to hold one single judged and one double judged/double point horse show in 2011, making it possible to haul once and earn three sets of points in almost all classes! We hope you will take advantage of this change to save money while earning more points!
- 2) Show Rules**

All horses will be shown in accordance with AQHA Rules.
- 3) Halter & Performance Entry Fees**

Entry fees are \$12 Fri/\$24 Sat & Sun for halter & \$15 Fri /\$30.00 Sat & Sun for performance. Youth entry fees are \$10 Fri/\$20 Sat & Sun for halter and performance classes. Payback premiums will be awarded under both judges.
- 4) Post and Late Entry Fees**

All entries postmarked by 8/18/11 will be at the regular fees above. All entries postmarked 8/19/11 or later and received in the show office by 5:00 pm 9/15/11 for Friday's show and by 5:00 pm 9/16/11 for the split/combined show will be considered late entries and will be charged a \$25 per horse one time post entry fee per show, which allows the horse to be entered in as many classes as desired at the regular entry fee by those deadlines. Any classes entered after 5:00pm on 9/15 for the first show and after 5:00 pm 9/16/11 for the split/combined show will be considered late entries and will be charged double the entry fee per show.
- 5) Membership Requirement**

Anyone exhibiting in an AQHA approved show must be a member of the American Quarter Horse Association; only Individual, Amateur and Youth members can participate in open classes (no joint memberships).

Send photocopy of membership card with entries. Any horse entered in an approved AQHA show must be listed under its complete registered name and number, or its Appendix or New Appendix name with the designation of Appendix or New Appendix following its name.
- 5) Ownership Requirement**

Horses must be entered and shown under the name of the owner as currently recorded with the AQHA at the time of entry, and no change of ownership will be permitted. No entries can be shown until show management inspects the registration papers or photocopy of both the front and back. These photocopies must accompany your entries. Exceptions: beginning in 2011, any youth or amateur exhibitor can lease a horse to show in AQHA events. To show a leased horse, an exhibitor needs a showing lease form from AQHA and a copy of the detailed agreement or contract between the horse's owner and the lessee.
- 6) Gelded Status**

Gelded status must be reflected on registration certificate for horse to be shown in Gelding classes. If your gelding's papers still show him as a stallion, we will have a Gelding Stamp in the show office to correct them for you.

7) Entry Blanks & Fees

You must fill out a separate entry blank and separate check for each breed or division you enter (ie, Quarter Horse and 4-H, Quarter Horse and Buckskin). Our computer requires this – thanks for your cooperation!

9) Incorrectly Completed Entry Forms

Entry errors (ownership problems, incorrect age groups, etc) result in fines to show management by the AQHA. In turn, show management will bill these fines to exhibitors. Exhibitors with unpaid fines are ineligible to enter future NMSF Horse Shows. Please make your entries carefully

10) Drug Testing Fee

For all AQHA approved shows held in the United States show management must collect a drug testing of \$5 per horse per judge

PERFORMANCE HALTER

1. The performance halter class is required in the Open, Amateur and Youth division when halter classes are offered. Only an all-age class will be held. Separate classes will be held for stallions, mares and geldings in the Open and Amateur divisions. Separate classes will be held for mares and geldings in the Youth division.
2. First and second place in the performance halter class will be eligible for Grand and Reserve in each sex division. The number of entries in the performance halter class count toward the total for each sex division in determining points for Grand and Reserve.
3. To be eligible to compete in the performance halter class, a Register of Merit in performance or racing must be earned and recorded on the horse's record. A racing Register of Merit only applies to the Open division. A performance Register of Merit must be earned in the division in which it is to compete, (for example: if a horse competes in the Amateur division, the performance Register of Merit must have been earned in the Amateur Division).

4. The Register of Merit applies to the horse. If the horse is transferred, the horse is eligible to compete with the new owner if the performance Register of Merit was earned in the particular division entered.
5. A horse may not show in the age division halter class and the performance halter class at the same show in a particular division.

Amateur Class Rules

To show in AQHA Approved Amateur Classes, a horse must meet the ownership and rider rules as described in the AQHA Rule Book. A photocopy of the registration certificate, showing ownership for each horse, as well as a photocopy of the exhibitor's Amateur Card must accompany each entry. The Amateur Number must be noted on the entry form. (Amateur exhibitor 19 and over.) To be eligible to show in Novice Amateur classes, the exhibitor must possess a Novice Amateur card and not have earned more than 10 AQHA Open and/or Amateur points as per Rule 405 of the AQHA Official Handbook. Novice amateurs cannot show stallions.

Beginning July 1, 2010, an exhibitor may show a horse in a novice youth or novice amateur class, with the owner and their immediate family still retaining the ability to show the horse in any class other than the same class as the novice exhibitor. Exhibitors will be required to have a novice amateur or novice youth membership to participate. Memberships can be purchased at the show or prior to the show through AQHA.

Youth Exhibitor Performance Classes are AQHA Youth Approved. To show in AQHA Approved Youth Classes, a horse must meet the ownership and rider rules as described in the AQHA Rule Book. A photocopy of the registration certificate showing ownership for each horse must accompany each entry. Youth's date of birth and youth number must be noted on the entry form. The age of an individual on JANUARY 1 of that year shall be maintained throughout the entire year. COPY of current youth card MUST be included with entries. Stallions are prohibited in all youth classes. To be eligible to show in Youth Novice classes, the exhibitor must possess a Youth Novice Card and not have earned more than 10 AQHA Open and Youth points per AQHA rules.

New Mexico State Fair High Point Youth Awards will be awarded to the top three youth riders in each age group based for the three day circuit, using points from all three judges. The AQHA point system will be used to compile points for the New Mexico State Fair Awards. AQHA Rule 417 (F) will prevail.

High Point Quarter Horse Awards (High Point & Reserve High Point) will be given for results under each of the two judges. Horse to be shown in halter as well as performance, and rider and owner are required to be current members of NMQHA. Trophies donated by the New Mexico Quarter Horse Assn. Points will be compiled using the following point system: AQHA Rule 417 F: 1st - 9 pts., 2nd - 8 pts., 3rd -7 pts., 4th - 6 pts., 5th -5 pts., 6th - 4 pts., etc. Fewer than 9 placing in a class, points will be awarded accordingly; i.e. 8 in class, 1st - 8 pts., 2nd - 7 pts., 3rd - 6 pts., 4th - 5 pts. Tie breakers will be: (1) Greatest number of 1st places. (2) Highest placings in most classes. (3) Points earned over the most horses. Categories of performance will not count.

AQHA All-Around Trophy will be awarded and sent to the winners by AQHA.

NMQHA High-Point Amateur and Novice Amateur Awards will be presented by the NM Amateur Quarter Horse Association. The awards will be given to the high point Amateur and Novice Amateur who is a member of NMQHA and NMAQHA. Awards will be based on the results under each of the two judges, and awards will be given under each judge, using the same point system as the High Point Quarter Horse award. High point awards based on one horse, one rider for youth & amateur awards.

(This fee includes one parking pass, one exhibitor's pass, and a stall for the day. All horses must have a stall.)
