Special Rules

****Read these rules carefully - they apply to all entries for the NMSF 4-H indoor exhibits!**

1. The New Mexico State Fair and 4-H Department shall not be held responsible for damage, loss, or theft of exhibits. All items are entered at your own risk. While we do our best to handle each item carefully and respectfully, there is always some risk of damage.
2. County Extension Agents or their designated representative are responsible for county exhibits. Individual entries will not be taken without explicit permission from the County Extension Office. Each County is responsible for their own entries. There will be no early drop-off of entries. Entries received with incorrect numbers will be returned to that County for renumbering.
3. Each county may bring only the first place exhibits from county fairs or achievement days in each class. Therefore, each county may enter only one exhibit per class, per section (novice, junior, senior).
4. Items must be entered in the appropriate age category: all ages are as of January 1 of the current 4-H year.
 - a. Novice - 8 years old and in the third grade or 9-11
 - b. Junior - 12-13 years old

c. Senior - 14-19 years old

* Cloverbuds - according to NM 4-H Policy, Cloverbuds are not eligible for competition and therefore can not be qualified at the county level. No Cloverbud entries are taken at the State Fair.

5. 4-H'ers must be enrolled in the appropriate project to compete in that class.
6. Judging will be based on the standards listed including any size guidelines in the 4-H project book. Judges determine the merit of each exhibit. If multiple qualified items are in a class, they will be placed 1st-3rd, however, a judge may determine that no item meets the standard for 1st and chose not to award one. No more than one of each placng may be awarded in each class. If an item is the only entry in a class, judges will judge the item against the standard and may choose to award a 1st, 2nd or 3rd placing or no placing at all.
7. Premiums are awarded by the New Mexico State Fair in the amount of \$5 for a 1st, \$4 for a 2nd and \$3 for a 3rd.
8. Tape or sew a label giving the exhibitor's name, county, and year of project on each article. This is in addition to the fair exhibitor label which must be placed on the front of the item and attached securely.
9. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and completed during the current 4-H year.
10. At the close of the fair, exhibit must be claimed by County Extension agent or an official representative of the exhibitor.

No later than 10 days prior to the entry date. Mailed or shipped entries will be returned in the same manner and in the same container received, provided funds to cover the transportation cost are included with the entry.
12. All items are displayed to the best of our ability. Cases will not be opened to move items, the exception being if items are upside down or mislabeled.
13. All entries must have an entry tag attached. Tags are color coded by age level: pink for Novie, yellow for Junior and green for Senior. Tags should contain the class number, project item description, memeber's name and county. Tags must be securely attached to the **front** of the item to allow for judging and display.
14. All Self-Determined entries must be accompanied by a completed Self-Determined Project Record Form 100.SD-1 (R-03). Self-Determined items that do not have a sheet will be disqualified - be sure the sheet is securely attached.
15. Exhibit sizing guidelines:
 - a. **Posters:** Posters may be no larger than 14 x 22 inches (this is half of a standard sheet of poster board). Posters are defined as any flat paper, foam board,

cardboard, or other backing appropriate for hanging on the wall for display. Flat items placed on stands or with stands attached will be considered posters and the stands will not be utilized for display.

- b. Display Boards:** Display boards may be no larger than 18 x 48 inches (this is a small size display board, or half of a standard display board). Display boards are defined as scored, freestanding science boards that may be purchased at any school supply store. These are boards made freestanding by the sides being folded in slightly.
- c. Other Exhibit Boards:** Exhibit bases for three dimensional vertical displays may be no larger than 24x24 inches. A vertical display is defined as an exhibit with a solid base where the exhibit itself rises up. This would apply to small engines, Self -Determined, or any other appropriate 3-D Display.
- d. Project Specific Boards:** Some project boards are given specific measurements within the project. For example, Leathercraft and braiding have guidelines in the project book. If an exhibit is defined by the project book that is the rule members must follow.
- e. Oversized Exhibits:** Because of security and space limitations, extremely large/heavy project exhibits may not be accepted for display in the 4-H Department; call (575) 646-1166 for prior approval on large Woods, Welding or other large project displays. This only applies to actual items - posters, display boards, and vertical displays may not be over-sized. We can not guarantee that oversized items will be placed behind glass.
- f. Photography Exhibits:** See specific sizing guidelines under the Photography Section. Photos may be mounted or matted with material strong enough to withstand transport and display (cardboard, mat board, poster board, etc.) We are not responsible for lost or damaged photos - please keep a copy of all prints submitted.

4-H Pie And Cake “Best Of Show” Contest

One fruit pie and one cake, made from scratch, will be selected for “Best of Show” honors. 4-H Best of Show Pie and 4-H Best of Show Cake will be in the Jr. Livesock Sale on Friday, September 17, 2010 at 1:00 pm. Winning youth will be required to be present with a fresh cake or pie the day of the sale.

4-H PIE AND CAKE “BEST OF SHOW” CONTEST

1. One fruit pie and one cake, made from scratch, will be selected for “Best of Show” honors.
2. 4-H Best of Show Pie and Best of Show Cake will be sold in the Jr. Livestock Sale at the New Mexico State Fair. Youth receiving a Best of Show award must be present at the Luncheon with a fresh Cake or Pie respective to what they won,

- in order to be eligible to sell. Failure to sell Pie or Cake will result in a forfeiture of all Best of Show awards, including rosettes and premiums.
3. The original pie and cake will be presented to the New Mexico State Fair Chairman and the Fair Commission after judging.
 4. The exhibitor must be a bona fide New Mexico 4-H member.
 5. The exhibitor must be currently enrolled in a food/nutrition project.
 6. An exhibitor may not enter a pie and cake in the same year.
 7. An exhibitor may only enter one cake or one pie - they can not compete against themselves.
 8. A county may have as many pies or cakes as that county wishes to qualify. Entries must be entered with permission from the County Extension Office in the exhibitor's county.
 9. The baked item is due at the 4-H Department in Youth Hall with the other county entries on entry day.
 10. Food containers will not be returned.
 11. The following items must be entered to be eligible for judging:
 - A fruit pie (no custard or egg filling for food safety reasons) or
 - An iced cake made from scratch (no custard or egg filling/icing)
 13. The following items must be entered in a report portfolio along with the pie or cake:
 - A Cover Page including photo of the pie or cake, exhibitor's name, name or recipe and county.
 - Copy of the recipe
 - 4-H Story (not to exceed 2 double space pages - margins are to be no smaller than 1 inch with font size of easy readability) including:
 1. Goals for foods project taken
 2. How pie/cake recipe was chosen
 3. How foods knowledge learned in 4-H will be used in the future
 4. Any other information exhibitor would like to share with the judges
 - 4-H Foods Project Records – include baking, foods/nutrition and food preservation for all years in 4-H. Place dividers between different projects.
- * This is a professional report, not a scrapbook. Do not add additional photos. Use only white paper with blue or black ink.

****Beginning with the 2006 New Mexico State Fair, a 4-H member who has won Best of Show with a pie or cake and sold at the Junior Livestock Sale may not enter the same category again in their 4-H career.**
