NMLB GUIDE FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

2010 SEASON

All out of state livestock must comply with New Mexico import requirements.

- Proof of ownership (NMLB "Form 1" inspection certificate) must accompany the animal when traveling; this will assure that all requirements have been met.

- Brands:

- 1.All in state show cattle must be branded with a New Mexico registered brand; if not that of the brand's registered owner, a bill of sale and a letter of permission from the brand's owner is required.

- 2.Fresh brands are not allowed – the brand must be "peeled and healed".

- 3.A freeze brand does not qualify as a New Mexico registered brand.

- 4.Cattle may be shown with the originating herd's New Mexico registered brand with a bill of sale and a letter of permission from that brand owner.

- 5.Certificates of Brand Exemption are allowed only on registered breeding cattle under that ownership. Steers do not qualify for a Certificate of Brand Exemption.

- All breeding bulls require a negative trichomoniasis test.

- All cattle are required to have a negative T.B.

- Steers must have a negative T.B. test. 1 test is good for the calendar show season.

- All sexually intact cattle over 4 months of age must have a negative T.B. test no more than 120 days prior to exhibition (applies to in-state cattle only).

- ACCREDITED TB FREE HERD STATUS WILL BE RECOGNIZED.

- 1) No copies or faxed copies of TB test charts (VS Form 6-22) or health certificates will be accepted unless signed by the veterinarian (who administered the test) in blue ink certifying the copy.

The exhibitor must bring these documents to fair check-in.

- 2) NMLB approved regulatory identification is required for all test eligible animals, regardless of species or breed.

- 3) Any clinical signs or evidence of an infectious and/or contagious disease will result in that animal's immediate removal from the fair grounds.

- 4) Out of state equine and livestock entries must adhere to New Mexico entry requirements and all current New Mexico fair entry requirements. Please call Dr. Dave Fly, (505)841-6161 for more information.

Entry Fee

Entry fees for each animal are \$20.00 (late fees if applicable) and must accompany the entry. Parking permit, Office, and Exhibitor Pass fees must also accompany the entry.

Arrival / Departure

Begins at noon on September 16th, 2010 but must be on grounds by September 17th, 2010 at 5:00 pm. Departure at conclusion of show.

Eligibility

American Hereford Association Regional Show for Horned Herefords and for Polled Herefords. The American Hereford Association, 1501 Wyandotte, Kansas City, MO 64101, (816) 842-3757. Exhibitors in Hereford classes are subject to the Association's special rule on class qualification, and any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible to show. All Hereford entries must be officially recorded at show time to be eligible to show. Entries with registrations "Pending" or "Applied for" will not be eligible to show.

Cow–Calf Pairs

15. Cow/Calf – Any female older than above ages with a calf at side.

A Calf older than 270 days of age on the show date is not eligible to show in cow/calf class. In the cow/calf class if the cow is horned and the calf polled, the the pair will show in the horned cow/calf class. If the cow is polled and the calf is horned, the the pair will show in the polled cow/calf class. The calf is eligible for individual classes, but must be entered in appropriate class.

All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in the respective single age classes.

35. Get of Sire – Four animals shown in above single entry classes with both sexes represented and all to be the progeny of one sire. It is permissible to use either the cow or calf from a cow/calf pair for the Get of Sire. Get of Sire may be comprised of animals from one or more owners.
36. Best Six Head – Owned by Exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective single entry classes and they must be owned by the exhibitor or by a member of their immediate family. A cow/calf will be considered as two head in the Best of Six Head class.
37. Heifers (only N. M. exhibitors eligible) Buckle
38. Bulls (only N. M. exhibitors eligible) Buckle

Point System Rules

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor: Awarded with the following point system 1st=5 pts., 2nd=4 pts., 3rd=3 pts., 4th=2 pts. and 5th=1pt.

No points will be given for champions. Points will be awarded for the Get of Sire and Best Six Head for Premier Exhibitor and Get of Sire for Premier Breeder. The same scoring system as above will be used for awarding points for the group classes.
