NMLB GUIDE FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS 2011 SEASON

CATTLE

- Proof of ownership (NMLB “Form 1” inspection certificate) must accompany the animal when traveling, whether in or out of the district; this is the assurance that all requirements have been met.
- Brands:
 - 1.All in state show cattle must be branded with a New Mexico registered brand; if the person showing the animal is not the brand’s registered owner, a bill of sale and a letter of permission from the brand’s owner is required.
 - 2.Fresh brands are not allowed – the brand must be “peeled and healed”.
 - 3.A freeze brand does not qualify as a New Mexico registered brand.
 - 4.Cattle may be shown with the originating herd’s New Mexico registered brand with a bill of sale and a letter of permission from that brand owner.
 - 5.Certificates of Brand Exemption are allowed only on registered breeding cattle under that ownership. Steers do not qualify for a Certificate of Brand Exemption.
- All breeding bulls require a negative trichomoniasis test. Exception - if health papers read “For exhibition only, not for sale or breeding” in lieu of test.
- All sexually intact dairy cattle over 4 months of age are required to have a negative TB test. TB tests will be honored for 120 days prior to showing.
- Registered breeding show heifers must be identified by official breed registry number; either tattoo or tag for purposes of traceability. Grade heifers will require the NMLB approved fair tag.
- Accredited TB-Free Herd status will be recognized.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- 1) No copies or faxed copies of TB test charts (VS Form 6-22) or health certificates will be accepted, unless signed by the veterinarian (who administered the test) in blue ink certifying the copy. The exhibitor must bring these documents to fair check-in.
- 2) NMLB approved regulatory identification is required for all test eligible animals.
- 3) Any clinical signs or evidence of an infectious and/or contagious disease will result in that animals immediate removal from the fair grounds.
- 4) Out of state equine and livestock entries must adhere to New Mexico entry requirements and all current New Mexico fair entry requirements. Please call the NMLB office for state entry requirements.

ANY ANIMAL, ARRIVING AT A SHOW OR FAIR, FOUND NOT TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH NEW MEXICO STATE STATUTES OR LIVESTOCK BOARD RULES WILL BE SENT HOME AND GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME COMPLIANT FOR FUTURE SHOWS AND FAIRS.

This information is provided only as a guide and may not contain all necessary requirements for livestock bound for exhibits and shows. It is extremely important to consult your 4-H Leader, FFA Advisor, County Agent and your Livestock Inspector for updated information well ahead of your planned date of transport. Be sure to contact the destination fairs and livestock shows for their own rules.

Entry Fee

Adult/Open

Regular Entry Fee for each animal in the Adult/Open is \$30.00 (late fees if applicable) and must accompany the entry. Separate entries must be submitted to show in each section. \$10 of the entry fee will go towards the Texas Longhorn Breeders of New Mexico (TLBNM). Parking Permit, Office and Exhibitor Pass fees (per person) must also accompany the entry.

Youth

Youth Entry Fee for each animal is \$30.00. All animals shown in Youth competition must be entered in the Adult/Open qualifying show. All youth entries, fees and applications will be processed through the TLBNM youth sponsor (not NM State Fair) and MUST be postmarked no later than August 5, 2011. The NM State Fair will provide ribbons for Youth winners, all other awards provided by New Mexico Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow (NMTLBT).

Arrival / Departure

Sunday, September 18th, 2011 at 12:00 pm and must be on grounds by Monday, September 19th, 2011 at 5:00 pm. Departure at conclusion of the show.

Eligibility & Rules

1. Entry forms must be completed
1. Cattle can be double registered but must present their registration to the TLBAA.
2. The owner of the cattle entered in a qualifying show must be a member in good standing of the TLBAA.
3. All cattle must be 120 days of age to exhibit at any show.
4. The section on grooming of animals will be strictly adhered to.
5. Any female over 30 months of age must have either a nursing Texas Longhorn calf at side or the results of a pregnancy test listed on the health certificate.
6. Calves shown with haltered dams must also be on halter and nursing calves (205 days or less) may be shown with its dam at the owners' discretion.
