Entry Fee

Entry fee for each animal is \$20.00 must accompany the entry. Parking permit, office fee, and exhibitor fees (per person) must also accompany the entry.

No late entries will be accepted. Exhibitors who have not submitted their entries by deadline will be refused stall space and will not be able to show.

Arrival / Departure

Begins at 12:00 pm on September 19, 2011 but must be on grounds by September 20, 2011 at 5:00 pm. Release at conclusion of show. Cattle must be off grounds by 8:00 am on September 24, 2011.

NMLB GUIDE FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS 2011 SEASON

CATTLE

- Proof of ownership (NMLB “Form 1” inspection certificate) must accompany the animal when traveling, whether in or out of the district; this is the assurance that all requirements have been met.
- Brands:
 1. All in state show cattle must be branded with a New Mexico registered brand; if not that of the brand’s registered owner, a bill of sale and a letter of permission from the brand’s owner is required.
 2. Fresh brands are not allowed – the brand must be “peeled and healed”.
 3. A freeze brand does not qualify as a New Mexico registered brand.
 4. Cattle may be shown with the originating herd’s New Mexico registered brand with a bill of sale and a letter of permission from that brand owner.
 5. Certificates of Brand Exemption are allowed only on registered breeding cattle under that ownership. Steers do not qualify for a Certificate of Brand Exemption.
- All breeding bulls require a negative trichomoniasis test.
- All dairy cattle over 4 months of age are required to have a negative TB test. Test is good for 120 days prior to showing.
- Breeding show heifers must be identified by breed registry number; tattoo or tag. for purposes of traceability.
- Accredited TB-Free Herd status will be recognized.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- 1) No copies or faxed copies of TB test charts (VS Form 6-22) or health certificates will be accepted, unless signed by the veterinarian (who administered the test) in blue ink certifying the copy. The exhibitor must bring these documents to fair check-in.
- 2) NMLB approved regulatory identification is required for all test eligible animals.

- 3) Any clinical signs or evidence of an infectious and/or contagious disease will result in that animals immediate removal from the fair grounds.
- 4) Out of state equine and livestock entries must adhere to New Mexico entry requirements and all current New Mexico fair entry requirements. Please call the NMLB office for state entry requirements.

ANY ANIMAL, ARRIVING AT A SHOW OR FAIR, FOUND NOT TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH NEW MEXICO STATE STATUTES OR LIVESTOCK BOARD RULES WILL BE SENT HOME AND GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME COMPLIANT FOR FUTURE SHOWS AND FAIRS.

This information is provided only as a guide and may not contain all necessary requirements for livestock bound for exhibits and shows. It is extremely important to consult your 4-H Leader, FFA Advisor, County Agent and your Livestock Inspector for updated information well ahead of your planned date of transport. Be sure to contact the destination fairs and livestock shows for their own rules.

SPECIAL RULES

1. Exhibitors may wear white shirts and blue denim jeans or dairy colors while in the show ring.
2. No animal can be entered or exhibited unless the same has been recorded in the recognized Book of Records for its respective breed, and exhibitors must produce the Certificate of Registry at the request of the Superintendent in charge anytime during the Fair. Name and registry number of sire and dam must be given for animal under six months.
3. All animals must be entered in the name of the owner and must have been owned by him not less than 30 days prior to the opening day of the Fair.
4. In Produce of Dam Class, each exhibitor is limited to one group entry produced by the same dam. Entries need not all be owned by one exhibitor.
5. A bull over one year old without a ring in his nose may be excluded from the show ring at the discretion of the Superintendent.
6. Individual animals shown in all groups and herd classes must have been entered and shown in one of the classes for single animals. In breeder's herd and best three female classes, each exhibitor is limited to one entry consistent with premier breeder and premier exhibitor designations by the exhibitor.
7. In classes for cows in milk, it is recommended that the cow be milked out after the judge has observed the udders distended.

8. Senior Yearling Heifers that have freshened may show in the 2 year old class.
9. Displays must remain in place until the end of the Dairy Cattle show on Sunday.
10. Bedding will not be provided by the New Mexico State Fair. Straw will be available and may be purchased at the feed store located on the fairgrounds.
11. Only 1-2 people may stay with the animals overnight. If additional accommodations are needed, the Youth Hall Dorms may be available.

Groups

\$20.00 per class

Group classes for each breed show shall be as follows:

Breeder's Herd of Five Females

This group, all owned by the exhibitor, consists of two females over two years of age, two females under two years of age and one any age. At least three must be bred by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.

Junior Best 3 Females

3 females, none of which have freshened - all owned and bred by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.

Senior Best 3 Females

3 females, at least 2 of which have freshened - all owned and at least 2 bred by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.

Dam and Daughter

Milking dam and one daughter, any age.

Produce of Dam

2 animals any age, produce of one cow, dam named.

PDCA Recommendation - It is recommended that exhibitor and breeder be defined as follows: "Where a herd is registered in the name of different members of a family, residing on one farm and where the herd is one unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for Premier Exhibitor, Premier Breeder, Dairy Herd, Breeder's Herd, State Herd, and Best Three Female Classes."

Awards

State Herd Award - Award will be paid on the percentage of number of herds within the state breed according to placings. For example: 2 herds would be paid 60:40. 8 head composed of 2 females, 2 years old or over; 3 females, under 2 years; 3 other females any age or 2 females any age and 1 bull any age. The 8 animals must be owned by not less than three exhibitors from that state with no exhibitor furnishing more than three animals. All animals in which a breeder owns a partnership interest will be counted in these three. All animals from a herd or farm, regardless of ownership, shall be counted in the three head allowed one exhibitor. Cattle owned by state institutions will be allowed to show in the state herd class, but all institutions in a state will

be considered one exhibitor and allowed to show not more than 3 head in a state herd group. Herd to be approved by the State Breed Association and Certificate of Approval to accompany herd. An inactive State Association shall furnish a certificate to designate breeder. (State Herd must be shown to receive award.)

Premier Exhibitor Award

The exhibitor winning the most points on, but not to exceed, six animals owned and exhibited by himself in the open single classes, shall be designated the Premier Exhibitor. The scale of points will be the same as that for determining Premier Breeder. (One per breed.)

Premier Breeder Award

The breeder winning the most points on, but not to exceed six animals in the Open Single Classes exhibited by himself and/or other exhibitors, shall be designated the Premier Breeder. The point system for determining Premier Breeder is as follows: (One per breed).
