### Best Display

#### Definition

In order to compete for Best Displays, an exhibitor must exhibit at least one cock, one hen, one cockerel, one pullet and one trio, all of one variety, standard varieties only.

#### Judging

A Best Display will be awarded on premium points to be counted for awards as follows (trios to count double):

First Premium, 6 points; Second Premium, 4 points; Third Premium, 3 points; Fourth Premium, 2 points; Fifth Premium, 1 point. The number of points won in each class to be multiplied by the number of birds in each class.

### Best Display - Waterfowl

#### Definition

In order to compete for Best Displays, an exhibitor must exhibit at least one young drake, young duck, old drake, old duck and three other of the same variety.

# Judging

A Best Display will be awarded on premium points to be counted for awards as follows:

First Premium, 6 points; Second Premium, 4 points; Third Premium, 3 points; Fourth Premium, 2 points; Fifth Premium, 1 point. The number of points won in each class to be multiplied by the number of birds in each class.
